2025 Legislative Leadership

The Kansas Legislature convened in Topeka on December 2nd to elect their new Senate and House leaders for the upcoming 2025-2026 biennium legislative session.

The elections set the stage for committee chair appointments and committee assignments.

Here's the new lineup of Senate and House leadership:

Senate Republicans:

- President: Incumbent Ty Masterson (Andover) – unopposed.

Vice President Tim Shallenburger (Baxter Springs) defeated Renee Erickson (Wichita) in the open position. This was the result of incumbent Rick Wilborn's (McPherson) retirement announcement. Wilborn will return to the House this fall to replace the late Les Mason (McPherson).

- Majority Leader: Chase Blasi (Wichita) beat incumbent Larry Alley (Winfield).

Caryn Tyson (Parker) emerged victorious in the Assistant Majority Leader race against Beverly Gossage (Eudora).

- Majority Whip: Incumbent Rick Kloos (Berryton) – unopposed.

Senate Democrats:

- Minority Leader: Incumbent Dinah Sykes (Lenexa) – unopposed.

• Assistant Minority Leader: Incumbent Oletha Faust-Goudeau (Wichita) beat Marci Francisco (Lawrence).

- Minority Whip: Cindy Holscher (Overland Park) – unopposed.

Incumbent Pat Pettey (Kansas City) did not run for a leadership position this year.

- Minority Agenda Chair: Incumbent Marci Francisco (Lawrence) unopposed.
